

# STMU 7<sup>th</sup> Convocation Code of Conduct

## **Date and Venue:**

The Convocation is scheduled to be held on <u>Saturday, January 11, 2020.</u> Graduating students will be required to be present at <u>8:30 a.m. (PST)</u> at the <u>Jinnah Convention Centre, Islamabad</u>.

Convocation rehearsals will be held on <u>Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2020</u> i.e. one day before the formal day of the Convocation.

#### Online Registration & Invitation Cards for Guests:

- ✓ Please note that the online registration for Convocation is mandatory for all graduating participants and their guests.
- ✓ For the online registration, Kindly visit our website <u>www.stmu.edu.pk</u>
- ✓ Deadline for the online registration is 20<sup>th</sup> December 2019
- ✓ No entry will be entertained after the due date.
- ✓ Each graduate will be issued up to <u>2 (two) single</u> invitation cards for their guests (parents/ Guardian/Spouse/Sibling of the graduate) as per information provided of the guests.
- ✓ Extra invitation cards may be issued on payment of **Rs. 1300** per invitation card.
- ✓ The payment will be submitted to accounts office directly from 23<sup>rd</sup> December to 27<sup>th</sup> December 2019.
- ✓ Entry will be strictly by invitation (bring original CNIC along with Invitation Card)
- ✓ Students are advised to instruct their guests to be on time. NO ENTRY WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER

  09:30 am or OTHERWISE AS MAY BE INSTRUCTED ON THE REHEARSALS DAY.
- ✓ The Management will not be responsible for any delays caused by traffic jam and queue on entrance.
- ✓ Invitation cards will be issued on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019 by the representative Student Affairs.

#### Rehearsal:

- ✓ Convocation rehearsals will be held on <u>Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2020</u> i.e. one day before the formal day of the Convocation.
- ✓ Graduates will be required to be at <u>8:30am (PST) at the Jinnah Convention Centre, Islamabad</u> for the rehearsal activities.
- ✓ The participation in Convocation rehearsals is mandatory for all graduating participants and attendance will be marked accordingly.
- ✓ The graduating participants who remain ABSENT on the day of rehearsal will not be allowed to take part in the formal Convocation ceremony.
- ✓ Graduates may register for the photographs on the day of Rehearsal.

# **Convocation Day:**

- ✓ The graduating participants reporting time for the day of Convocation will be **8:30am.**
- ✓ The attendance will be marked at <u>09:30am sharp.</u>
- ✓ Cameras and mobile phones are strictly prohibited during the convocation ceremony.
- ✓ Medals, distinctions and citations will be announced/awarded in the convocation ceremony.
- ✓ The original degree will not be awarded in the convocation ceremony. Graduates can collect their degrees from their respective Student Affairs Office on Tuesday <u>14<sup>th</sup>January 2020</u> after the submission of clearance form.

### **Discipline:**

- 1. Please extend full cooperation with the Security Staff on duty, and avoid arguing with them or acting against their advice.
- 2. Cooperate with the University /College and Hall Staff and members of Faculty and Staff and Event Ushers and follow their directions during rehearsal as well as in convocation ceremony to make it a happy memorable day for you.
- 3. Maintain discipline at all times during rehearsal as well as convocation ceremony.
- 4. Mobile phones are strictly prohibited during the convocation ceremony.
- 5. Avoid littering, gossiping and roaming around during the entire proceedings of the convocation.
- 6. Walk in line, follow the rhythm and remain seated once inside the ceremony hall.
- 7. Smoking is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Briefcase, Cameras and other similar items will not be allowed to be brought in the hall. Due to security/safety reasons the management of the University & Hall shall not be responsible for your belongings.
- 9. Follow the program of the ceremony in all respects.
