

NOTICE- Revised Attendance Policy

Dated: February 15, 2022

Dear Students,

Shifa College of Medicine has always tried to maintain high academic standards. In this regard the attendance policy has been revised. According to the policy:

- 1. Students are required to maintain 100% attendance. To cater for illness and other unforeseen events, an allowance of 10% will be permitted. However, the students will have to justify every absence by submitting an application to the Course/Clerkship Director countersigned by their parent/guardian.
- 2. Students with <u>less than 90% attendance</u> in a block/clerkship will not be allowed to sit in the Annual Examination and will appear in 2nd Annual Examination.
- 3. Students with <u>less than 75% attendance</u> will not be allowed to sit in the Annual or 2nd Annual Examinations. They will repeat the block/clerkship in the next academic year.
- 4. Cumulative attendance of all clinical years in each clerkship must be at least 90% for the students to be eligible to appear in Annual Examination.
- 5. Cases of students having less than 75% due to circumstances beyond their control will be referred to a Special Committee on Attendance. The Special Committee will deliberate upon and decide accordingly.
- 6. Students who have to repeat a year after failing the 2nd Annual examination will be required to attend that block/clerkship she/he has failed. Attendance policy will remain the same.
- 7. Students are expected to be punctual for their classes. Presence will not be marked if they are late.
- 8. Electives will only be done during the period prescribed for them and not during clerkships.

This policy will be applicable from the upcoming modules/clerkship in the current academic year.
